Approval of Meeting Notes for November 2022 and February 2023

Committee Members

- **Motion:** Sean Hughes made a motion to approve the November 2022, and February 2023 REPAC meeting notes, Steve Howie 2nd the motion. The motion carried.

Business Item

- Removal of the Wildland Fire working group from being an active member of REPAC Working Groups
- **Motion:** Randy Renois made a motion to remove the Wildland Fire working group from REPAC, Sean Hughes 2nd the motion. The motion carried.
- Approval of New Scoring Process, Criteria, and Priorities
 - Cody gave an AAR update which led to the vote of removing prior scoring criteria to a new ranking process.
 - Discussion – should working groups only submit 1 project instead of 2.
 - The recommendation is 5 minutes per project, maximum 2 projects per working group, 10 minutes total.
 - Discussion – priority, scoring and funding.
 - Discussion – Ranking vs. Scoring Criteria. Need some criteria for evaluation. Possibly moving to a ranking system.
 - Marcie described FEMA's scoring criteria.
 - Regional Scope Yes/No
 - Terrorism Yes/No
 - This year the goal is to have a sample score, a packet with information for the COG portal, and a presentation to review and pre-rank. You can expect this information 7 days prior to scoring.
- **Motion:** Jamie Moore made a motion to approve the new scoring process, criteria, and priorities, Chase Wheeler 2nd the motion. The motion carried.

Discussion Items

- New REPAC Rotation Process
 - 2023 – EOD, Fusion, T&E, and UAS will be added
 - 2024 – PubEd, CCP will be added, and 1 Interop seat will be removed and rotating off
 - 2025 – Hazmat, USAR, SWAT and EGRT will be added
 - Nominations are accepted until June 30, 2023. Nominations will be accepted and voted on at the August 3, 2023, REPAC meeting.
 - Discussion – SME seats, REPAC Handbook update, and Grant Guidance, working groups participation.
 - REPAC Chairs will work with COG staff on the REPAC Handbook. Will provide an update at the next REPAC meeting.
- Grant Dashboard & Project Update
 - EPPC and REPAC Chairs will be able to see all information on the Grant Dashboard. Working Group Chairs will only be able to see their projects. Grant Dashboard was presented.

- GY24 Timeline
 - August – COG staff will meet with working groups to determine projects for GY24.
 - COG staff will be hosting a Project Assistance Workshop.
 - Working Groups will be responsible for writing their projects.
 - October 13th – All projects are due in the COG Portal.
 - October 20th – PowerPoint presentations are due to COG.
 - November 1st – REPAC Scoring Meeting.
 - November 15th – EPPC Funding Meeting.
 - End of November – Release priority and funding allocations to the region as recommended by EPPC Funding Sub-committee. If something changes dramatically, EPPC Funding Sub-committee will meet again in January to go back over the funding.
 - February – REPAC meeting for final discussion. All projects will be in egrants by February 8th.
