Previously, cities outside the Dallas-Fort Worth-Arlington, Denton-Lewisville, and McKinney Urbanized Areas paid 2/3 of the amount of those in the UA. NCTCOG suggests keeping this factor or setting a flat rate such as that for the under 3,000 population.

Phase I Non-Municipal Agency

Phase II Non-Municipal Agency


Cost share is \$ 2,500 and is based on a zero-population factor.

REVIEW NOTES:

The county population used in the old formula to derive the cost-share was based on the **unincorporated** population of the county found in the Census 2010 **urbanized area**. A 2014 growth factor was applied to this population figure the last time there were updates (around 2016) which was then used with the Phase II cost share formula.

Counties are all designated Non-traditional Small MS4s (Level 2b) unless they have been granted a waiver (*).

NCTCOG is open to suggestions and encourages a discussion on how to update the County cost shares. A suggestion is setting a flat amount unless a county has a waiver. The average of all current non-waiver county cost shares is \$2,842. Suggestion of setting the flat amount at \$3,100. For counties granted a waiver, suggest 2/3 of flat amount (\$2,046) for their cost share if they chose to participate in the program.
