2125A/B: The group wants to look at the TxDOT details before the next meeting.
2150: The Subcommittee would like to remove the keyway joint.
2155: The Alley and Commercial approach should have a minimum of 3600 PSI. Also, add a note “over 12% grade break is not recommended.”
2160: The subcommittee asked to look at other options for having residential, commercial, and alley approach.
2170: The Subcommittee asked to get the Sustainable Public Rights-of-Way Subcommittee’s thoughts on this detail. They want to collaborate with the other groups that are working on similar content.
2180: The sand cushion should be changed to “Should not exceed over X inches.”
2115: The NCTCOG resource is outdated and Olivia will work with the Transportation Department to find an updated resource. Add note, “Where sulfates are present, consult a geotechnical engineer for recommended subgrade treatment.”

Olivia will email the Subcommittee the curb ramp detail from TxDOT and driveway approaches from other cities.
