6. Danielle Gygi, Project Manager, Whitehead Environmental Solutions, LLC, will brief the Subcommittee on their investigation findings for CLI (Closed Landfill Inventory) Site U834, located at 373 Retta Road in Mansfield.

Danielle Gygi along with Michael Whitehead, Whitehead Environmental Solutions, presented site details, including aerial photographs and previous reports to make a case for removing Site U834 from the Closed and Abandoned Landfill Inventory.

ACTION ITEM

7. The Subcommittee will discuss the findings for CLI site U834 and vote whether to recommend to the Resource Conservation Council (RCC) that the site should be removed from NCTCOG's Closed and Abandoned Landfill Inventory.

The Subcommittee did not vote on this action item at this time, pending additional information on the protocol for removing sites from the Closed and Abandoned Landfill Inventory from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

- 8. Next Steps- The RCC will vote on the Subcommittee's conformance recommendation for the HD Waste and Recycling Transfer Station at its next meeting on Wednesday, February 28, 2024. After this meeting, a letter stating the RCC's final conformance determination will be submitted to TCEQ, and a copy will also be sent to the applicant. The subcommittee will revisit the request to remove Site U834 from the Closed and Abandoned Landfill Inventory upon receipt of further guidance from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
