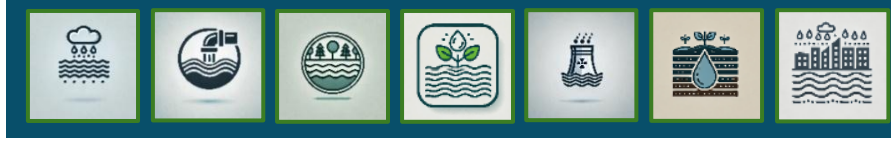

- ◆ **Hold (held) a role** where you **oversee, manage, plan, direct, organize, design,** and/or **control operational** and/or **organizational decisions** involving the aforementioned services. This includes but is not limited to; CEOs, managers, directors, engineers, planners, and scientists.

Who is the Survey Directed to?

- ◆ **All** who meet the **criteria above may participate.**
- ◆ Those with **knowledge of NbS, green stormwater infrastructure (GSI), green infrastructure (GI), or blue-green solutions (BGS)** for stormwater, wastewater, or water for consumptive use treatment may be best equipped to participate
