Trinity River CDC Tracking System Guide



The Corridor Development Certificate (CDC) process aims to stabilize flood risk along the Trinity River. The CDC process does not prohibit floodplain development, but ensures that any development that does occur in the floodplain will not raise flood water levels or reduce flood storage capacity. A CDC permit is required to develop land within a specific area of the Trinity Hoodplain called the Regulatory Zone, which is similar to the 'too'year floodplain. Under the CDC process, local governments retain ultimate control over floodplain permitting decisions, but other communities along the Trinity River

Grand are given as your and government on projects in their neighbor's jurisdiction. As the Metroplex economy continues to grow and develop, the CDC process will help prevent increased flood risks.

When you submit the application, email notices go out to all CDC members and the 30 day comment period begins. When there are 10 days left in the comment period, a reminder email will be sent out.

Commenting on Applications

When a new application is submitted, all CDC communities will receive an email notification of the new application. In this email is the direct link to that application within Qntrl. Click the direct link in your email or log into the system and locate the application to view all the details and documentation.

To comment on an application, scroll to near the bottom of the page. Here you will find an open text field to input your comments. Be sure to click "Post Comment" to submit your comment.

The applicant will receive an email for each comment submitted. All comments are stored in the system and can be viewed by scrolling to the bottom of the application details page.

Comments are only viewable within the Qntrl system and are not posted to the public facing website.

Additional notes about the system

You can view an application's location within the CDC process by clicking "Blueprint - Preview" in the top right corner of the green action bar.

The current state will be highlighted in orange. White boxes are stages/statuses and blue/teal boxes are the action buttons. Buttons will only be visible to users at the appropriate stage and that have permissions to perform the action.



Any time an application's status is updated, the public facing website will be updated automatically to reflect the new status.
