# Water conservation signage:



Use leftover drinking water or ice to water indoor plants or ask your coworkers if they have a use for it. The average American uses 80-100 gallons of water a day for indoor use, so reuse when you can to reduce your use!



# FILL THE DISHWASHER

Running full loads in the dishwasher is both a water and energy wise choice! Regularly underfilling the dishwasher could mean up to double the amount of water and energy used compared to a fully loaded dishwasher.

# **WATCH OUT FOR LEAKS!**

Watch for signs of water leakage and report any concerns or issues you see! The sooner a leak is noticed and reported, the sooner it can be fixed.



Choose to sweep sidewalks and shop floors instead of pressure washing them. Using a broom can save 8-18 gallons of water per minute!



# Water conservation signage:



What's the weather forecast today? Don't run irrigation in the rain or freezing temperatures. Properly maintaining sprinkler heads and irrigation systems conserves both water and energy resources!
