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

#### **(SIG) Modern Aviation FBO, San Juan, PR 48,000 SF New Hangar Construction**

Development of two (2) new hangars 24,000 SF hangars at Fernando Luis Ribas Dominicci Airport in San Juan, Puerto Rico for Modern Aviation.



#### **(BFI) Modern Aviation FBO, Seattle, WA FBO Remodel**

Full redesign and remodel of Modern Aviation's FBO at Seattle's Boeing Field. The remodel included a full rethinking of the terminal entrance and reception area.



#### **(BFI) Modern Aviation FBO, Seattle, WA 72,000 SF Hangar/Office, and Ramp Construction**

Design and development of two (2) hangars consisting of 64,500 SF of business aviation hangars and 7,500 SF of accompanying office space. The hangars included design challenges due to Part 77 bulk plane limitations, as well as extensive ramp performance challenges.



#### **(FNL) Discovery Air, Loveland, CO 42,000 SF Business Aviation Hangar**

The Torrey's Peak hangar is a 30,000 SF hangar with 12,000 SF of office and shop space. It is the first hangar developed as part of the multi-phased master planned development known as Discovery Air.



#### **(APA) Modern Aviation FBO, Centennial, CO 64,500 SF Hangar, FBO, and Ramp Construction**

Design, development and construction management of Modern Aviation's New FBO and hangar campus at Centennial Airport. The project included a two hangars, and FBO terminal, and new apron.



#### **(BUF) Signature Aviation, Buffalo, NY FBO and Hangar Renovation**

Full redesign and remodel of Signature Aviation's FBO at Buffalo International Airport. The renovation included a redesign of the terminal and renovation of the adjacent hangars.



#### **(APA) AeroColorado I, Centennial, CO 55,000 SF Private Hangar/Office**

AeroColorado is a 55,000 square foot class A aviation office/hangar facility that caters to private and corporate aviation tenants. Located in the InterPort campus at Centennial Airport, this state-of-the-art facility has been designed with opulent finishes, operational and energy efficiency.



#### **(APA) AeroColorado II, Centennial, CO 25,000 SF Private Hangar/Office**

AeroColorado II is a 25,000 SF facility comprised of 15,000 SF of hangar space and 10,000 SF of office and shop space. The development features various improvements over AeroColorado I, including enhanced snow melt system, efficient space, and covered parking.

The development of a new Customs and Boarder Protection facility at Shreveport International Airport.



**(RDG) Millenium Aviation, Provo, UT  
FBO Campus Design and Concept Budgeting**

Millenium Aviation FBO Campus redesign and budgeting. Evaluation of three (3) separate hangar development options and layout.



**(FNL) AeroFNL, Loveland, CO  
77,000 SF Box Hangars**

AeroFNL is 77,000 SF box hangar development at the Northern Colorado Regional Airport. The new development is the largest of its kind at the airport, featuring 23 individual executive box hangars.







# Airports Overview

## Dallas Fort Worth International Airport (DFWIA)

- Serves as the primary hub for arrival/departure point for tournament teams, VIPs, media, and fans.
- **FIFA Support**
  - Five total Concierge Desks – Terminal A (1), B (1), D (2), and E (1)
    - Will assist travelers with info and wayfinding.
  - Terminals B, D, and E will feature special TSA lanes for credentialed FIFA VIPs (Levels 1–4).
  - 60-70 volunteers on site everyday.
- **VIP Movement**
  - Dedicated load zones and temporary signage at each terminal will support teams and VIP transport.
- **Off-Terminal Facilities**
  - Hangar 5 and the Cargo Facility will serve as secured, police-supervised operations centers for teams, VIPs, and private charters.

# Airports Overview

## Dallas Love Field Airport

- **FIFA Support:**
  - Up to four FIFA staff onsite during the 35-day activation period with designated office space.
  - In-terminal concierge desk to assist FIFA personnel, guests, and volunteers with information and wayfinding.
  - 10-15 volunteers on site everyday.
- **Security & Access:**
  - Secure, non-public loading areas for high-security individuals and VVIPs.
  - Preferential lane available to expedite access for accredited FIFA personnel.
- **Charter Operations:**
  - Managed through two Fixed Base Operators on the west side (via Lemmon Avenue).
  - Charter flights coordinated with airport operations and U.S. Customs and Border Protection.

- Final Mobility Plan due end of March 2026
- Continue Meetings with Working Groups as Needed
- Refine Charter Bus Availability and Partnerships (Upcoming Agreement with Dallas Sports Commission)
- Formalize with City of Arlington use of Rideshare Technology Company Lot (Upcoming Agreement with the City of Arlington)
- Class 1 Railroad assistance (no freight trains blocking traffic) – working with USDOT
- Finalize After-Action Report/Improvement Plan for Coordinated Emergency Response on Regional Rail System/Get Funds Returned to NCTCOG

## Program Overview – Key Points and Allowable Uses

### Key Points

- Total funding: \$625M | Anticipated 9 awards | Range: \$32M-\$74M
  - \$250M for Counter UAS and Mitigation Systems
- Eligible applicant: State Administrative Agency (SAA) only; funds pass to Host City Committee Task Forces
- Mandatory pass-through: 100% of funds to local/tribal via Host City Committee Task Forces within 45 days
- Application deadline: Dec 5, 2025, 5:00 p.m. ET (SAA submits)

### Allowable Uses

- Planning, Organization, Equipment, Training & Exercises tied to World Cup security
- C-UAS detection/mitigation tech, sensors & software (non-weaponized)
- Operational overtime & surge personnel (subject to FEMA process)

**SUBJECT:** FIFA World Cup Grant Program Notice of Funding Opportunity

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), a component of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, is pleased to announce the release of the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the FIFA World Cup Grant Program (FWCGP). This program will provide \$625 million in federal funding to enhance security and preparedness for the 2026 FIFA World Cup events in the United States.

This standalone grant program supports the safe execution of the largest sporting event in history, co-hosted with Canada and Mexico, which is expected to attract over five million international visitors and generate tens of billions of dollars in economic activity across 11 U.S. host cities over 38 days. Funding will be allocated through State Administrative Agencies (SAAs) to Host City Committee Task Forces, which will make subawards to local governments to implement security measures for players, attendees, venues, and critical infrastructure.

Due to the current lapse in federal government funding, FEMA is unable to update [Grants.gov](#) or FEMA Grants Outcomes (FEMA GO) at [go.fema.gov](#) with new funding opportunities. To prevent delays in supporting these critical events, the FWCGP NOFO and all application materials are being distributed via email to the eligible SAAs. FEMA is accepting applications via email during the lapse to ensure jurisdictions can still apply for funding without interruption. Once the lapse in funding is resolved, FEMA may transition back to accepting applications through FEMA GO, and additional communication will be provided to applicants regarding this





# Texas Annual Funding Comparison




# Texas Grants by Funding Source 2025





# Federal Electric Take off and Landing (eVTOL) Integration Pilot Program SIR

## Program Overview – Purpose, Eligibility and Key Constraints

### Purpose

- Demonstrate, evaluate, and accelerate safe integration of electric Vertical Takeoff and Landing (eVTOL) aircraft into U.S. airspace and airport environments.
- Generate operational data to inform FAA policy, certification, infrastructure standards, and community integration.



### Eligibility & Key Constraints

- **Aircraft:** American-manufactured eVTOL (or comparable electric aircraft) in active FAA certification; capable of near-term flight demonstrations.
- **Participants:** Airport sponsors, OEMs, operators, vertiport/infrastructure firms, research partners, and public agencies.
- **Program Nature:** Non-funded pilot—participants are expected to carry their own costs; in-kind contributions encouraged.
- **Safety & Compliance:** Must operate under applicable FAA approvals (e.g., Part 135/experimental/exemptions) and local airport policies.
