The July 21, 2022 meeting summary was approved.

3. **Member Highlight Presentation.** Duy Vu, City of Cedar Hill, will present Cedar Hill's new household hazardous waste (HHW) home pickup program through WM's At-Your-Door.

Duy Vu, City of Cedar Hill, shared a presentation on the new program for collecting household hazardous waste at residential homes through WM's At-Your-Door service. The presentation included statistics on participation, amounts collected, and more. The presentation is <u>available</u> online for review.

4. **Annual Holiday Grease Roundup Update.** NCTCOG will provide an update on the upcoming Holiday Grease Roundup event, scheduled for November 14, 2022 through January 9, 2023.

The Ninth Annual Holiday Grease Roundup has 43 participants and 65 drop off locations and is scheduled for November 14, 2022 through January 9, 20234. NCTCOG is working to update the website and associated marketing materials and will distribute as appropriate.

 Promotional Activities Update. NCTCOG will provide an update on promotional activities and provide analytics from the Defend Your Drains website and social media activities. Additionally, NCTCOG will request feedback on future promotional activities from members during the meeting.

NCTCOG shared analytics from the Defend Your Drains North Texas social media posts and website. Attendees discussed the social media calendar/schedule and Spanish video translations.

6. Statewide FOG and Non-Flushables Campaign Discussion. NCTCOG and attendees will discuss the <u>Water Environment Association of Texas's (WEAT) statewide campaign</u> that includes digital marketing materials, animated videos, and more. NCTCOG will also request feedback from attendees on potentially participating as a partner in this campaign.

Attendees discussed potential participation in the Water Environment Association of Texas (WEAT) Unflushables campaign. Attendees instructed NCTCOG to continue seeking additional information on this campaign and potential impacts on Defend Your Drains North Texas messaging.

7. **Regional Training Discussion.** NCTCOG will request input from attendees on potential topics and scheduling for the FY2023 regional training.

Attendees selected Field Technician Training for the FY2023 training topic. This training will likely be held in Irving in Spring 2023 and will include presentations from the Cities of Irving and Grand Prairie.

8. **FY2023 Work Program Update.** NCTCOG will provide a brief update on the FY2023 Work Program, including preliminary budget and commitments received. NCTCOG will also present the FY2022 WATER Work Program Summary.

NCTCOG presented the <u>FY2022 WATER Work Program Summary</u>, which is available online for review. NCTCOG also provided an update on the preliminary FY2023 budget and tasks. NCTCOG is accepting commitments for FY2023 via email at <u>hallen@nctcog.org</u>.

Attendees discussed the needs to potentially increase cost-share amounts and how to increase overall participation. NCTCOG will be distributing a survey to determine cost-share needs in 2023.

The Trash Free Waters Single-Use Plastic Reduction Workgroup meeting is scheduled for November 7, 2022 at 2:30 PM via Microsoft Teams.
