Texas Smartscape

- TXSmartScape.com has a huge plant database available to help finish up your seed and plant orders for the upcoming spring. Search by region, plant type, sun light/water demands, landscape use, native or adapted, season and more!
- Perennial Protection: After a frost has "hardened off" perennials, it is helpful to add mulch (1" to 2" layer). Do not mulch too early or the mulch may encourage new growth which can be killed by a sudden hard freeze. Don't have perennials? Find yours at TXSmartScape.com

Doo the Right Thing

- Pet waste doesn't just decompose. It adds harmful bacteria and nutrients to local waters, when it's not disposed of properly. #DooTheRightThing by always picking up after your pets DFWStormwater.com/PetWaste
- Carry a bag with you on every walk with your dog, so you can #DooTheRightThing and throw it in the nearest trash can. DFWStormWater.com/PetWaste

Fats, Oils, and Grease

- Disposing of grease down drains can lead to clogged pipes and sewage backups. Proper disposal and recycling locations can be found at DefendYourDrainsNorthTexas.com
- Prescription pharmaceuticals and over-the-counter medications should never go down the drain or into the toilet, they end up in the water supply because water treatment processes can't completely remove them. #DefendYourDrains at DefendYourDrainsNorthTexas.com
