a. Dallas Fort Worth Air Quality Improvement Plan: Clean Vehicle Measures

Summary: Savana Nance presented an overview of the goals for the Clean Vehicle Initiatives Team from the DFW Clean Cities Strategic Plan. She also showed how these goals relate to proposed Clean Vehicle Measures to be included in the DFW Air Quality Improvement Plan Comprehensive Action Plan. Committee input was requested on appropriate targets and potential barriers, or other measures to consider.

There was substantial discussion. Overall, the committee was supportive but recommended being more aggressive in setting targets. A suggestion was made to revisit this for further discussion at a dedicated meeting or at the next regular Technical Advisory Committee meeting. Staff asked the Committee to review the materials further following the meeting and to provide additional feedback before the next meeting.

b. Goal Revision

Summary: Savana Nance presented an overview and update on progress towards achieving the remaining DFWCC Strategic Plan Goals, including the goals for Alternative Fuel Infrastructure Initiatives, Clean Energy Initiatives, and Organization /Capacity Building.

c. Opportunities for Impactful Projects

Summary: Lori Clark shared a handout illustrating specific projects that are currently funded and ongoing and how they connect to the Strategic Plan goals. She indicated that budget requests for fiscal year 2028 and beyond are coming up soon and asked for input on where additional resources should be invested, taking into account where resources currently are available.
