### 1. Welcome and Introductions.

Meeting participants introduced themselves and, as requested by the Chair, provided an overview of their work and/or any current issues. Most members noted the challenge of managing growth with aging infrastructure.

## Action Items

### 2. Meeting Summary.

The April 23, 2019 meeting summary will be presented for approval.

Greg Dickens, City of Hurst, made a motion to approve the April 23, 2019 meeting summary, and Wes Kucera, City of Garland, seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

### 3. Approval of the Draft 2019 Update to the Water Quality Management Plan.

Comments received at the public hearing will be summarized, and the Water Resources Council will vote to locally adopt the Draft 2019 Update to the Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP). The draft WQMP will be amended to incorporate public comments and recommended for endorsement by the NCTCOG's Executive Board.

No comments on the Draft 2019 WQMP were received at the public hearing. NCTCOG did receive comments from two entities via email: The City of Garland and the City of Retreat. The City of Garland provided edits and updates to the data in Appendices B and C, and the City of Retreat stated that "the water for the citizens of the City of Retreat is purchased by Community Water Company through the City of Corsicana. The City of Retreat does not own the water lines or water meters." The Water Resources Council had no comments on the Draft 2019 WQMP. Kevin Mercer, Denton County Fresh Water Supply District 6 & 7, made a motion to adopt the Draft WQMP and Wes Kucera, City of Garland, seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

## Discussion

### 4. FY2020 Water Resources Council Membership.

NCTCOG will present the draft FY2020 Water Resources Council membership structure. NCTCOG will request volunteers for a nominating subcommittee to review appointments for the Utility Provider, Development Community, or Industry

Representative Region-at-Large and the Environmental/Public Interest Groups Positions and also to fill any vacancies as desired.

A nominating subcommittee was formed, and it will meet via conference call. Their recommendations will be presented electronically for WRC review and approval.

5. **86<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislative Session Update.** NCTCOG will provide an update on relevant legislative bills.

NCTCOG provided an updated legislative matrix and highlighted a few bills of interest to the WRC.

6. **Future Agenda Items.** The committee can request future agenda items.

The WRC suggested a discussion and/or presentation of the results of Tarrant Regional Water District's Service Area Study. Another suggestion was updates on member's progress towards the Risk and Resiliency Assessments due to EPA by March 30.

7. **NCTCOG Updates.** NCTCOG will update the WRC on recent and upcoming items of interest.

NCTCOG provided the WRC with updates on the three items listed below:

1. NCTCOG found the City of Cleburne's project to be in conformity with the 2018 Water Quality Management Plan and submitted a letter to TCEQ stating this in June.
2. NCTCOG submitted a letter of support to TCEQ, on behalf of the WRC, for the Frognot Special Utility District.
3. NCTCOG is still gathering information on the administration of Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) Funds and will provide a more in-depth update at the next meeting.

8. **Roundtable.** WRC members share what is happening in their communities.

Roundtable items were covered in the Welcome and Introductions.

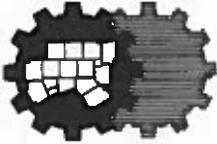
