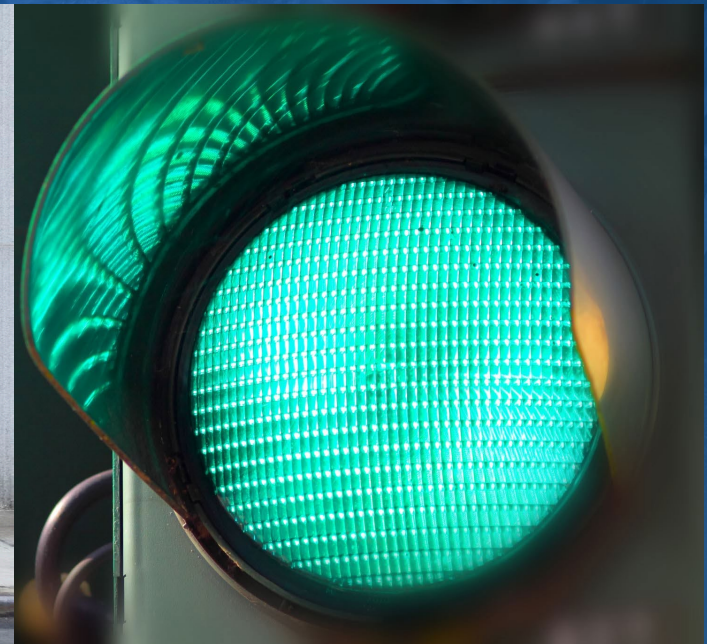
Communication Strategy

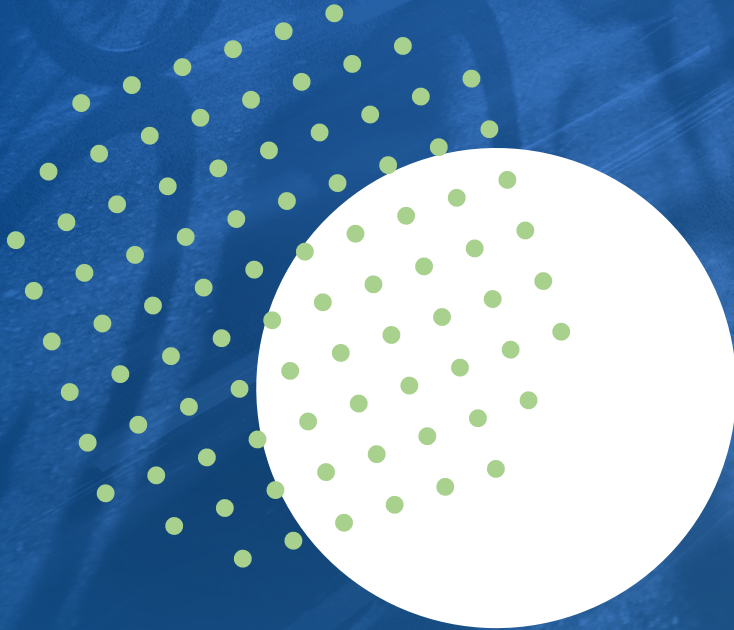
Street Infrastructure

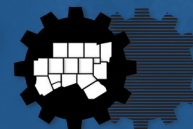
