Liquid Waste Hauling-TCEQ Classes of Wastes

- Grease
- ▶ Grit
- Septic
- ▶ Chemical Toilet

30 TAC §312.141(a) covers the above classes of wastes but also includes "biosolids/sewage sludge" and "water treatment residuals" but that is not applicable to any activities found within Cedar Hill city limits









City Ordinance

- Chapter 18. Article VIII.- I Liquid Waste; Generation, Transportation, and Disposal
- ► Sec. 18-331. –Permit Required.
 - ▶ (a)A person commits an offense if he operates or causes to be operated a vehicle for the purpose of transporting liquid waste without an applicable permit. A permit shall be issued for transportation of the liquid waste and regulatory authority shall designate on the permit the liquid waste authorized for transportation in the vehicle. A separate vehicle permit number is issued for each vehicle operated.


City Ordinance

- Chapter 18. Article VIII.- I Liquid Waste; Generation, Transportation, and Disposal
- ► Sec. 18-334. –Same-Inspection.
 - ▶ (a)A liquid waste transporter's vehicle shall be inspected by the regulatory authority prior to the issuance of a vehicle permit with qualifications as follows:







Inter-City Inspection Partnership

- We accept permits from Dallas, Fort Worth, Grand Prairie in lieu of an inperson inspection
 - Other cities on a case-by-case basis
- A copy of their <u>signed</u> permit and some way to verify that the permit number belongs to the correct vehicle
 - Sometimes requires the inspection report
- We all inspect for the same things anyway!
- Allows for quicker processing of applications

LWH PERMIT NOTIFICATION

Thank you for obtaining the 2022 City of Cedar Hill Liquid Waste Hauler permit. We look forward to working with you. Chapter 18 Article VIII of the City of Cedar Hill Code of Ordinances establishes the liquid waste hauler permit and requirements. Attached to this letter are the liquid waste hauler permit stickers required to comply with this article. Each permit is valid for the calendar year, January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022, regardless of the date of issuance.

The laminated and signed permit should be kept at a central office location and not required to be with each driver. A copy of the city's inspection report is also included and should be used to ensure the correct permit sticker goes on each vehicle. Place the permit sticker in a visible and prominent area at the rear of your liquid waste hauling vehicle. The permit shall be displayed on your vehicle during the entire length of the permit.

In addition, Chapter 18 Article VIII requires grease and grit liquid waste haulers to submit waste manifests to the city within 30 days of disposal. You will use your own waste manifests; the city does not have blank waste manifests available. Physical copies may be mailed in "Attn: Public Works/ Environmental Services" or alternately they may be scanned and sent to LWH@cedarhilltx.com. You are encouraged to report grease and grit interceptors that require maintenance to the abovementioned email address so the city may address it with the generator.

Failure to comply with any portion of Chapter 18, Article VIII of the City of Cedar Hill Code of Ordinances may result in, but is not limited to, <u>revocation of your permit, vehicle impoundment,</u> judicial proceedings, and fines of up to \$2000 per day.

City Ordinance

- Chapter 18. Article VIII.- I Liquid Waste; Generation, Transportation, and Disposal
- ► Sec. 18-341. Denial, suspension, revocation of permit
 - ▶ (a)The regulatory authority may deny a permit if it is determined that an applicant is not qualified under this article and may suspend or revoke a permit if it is determined that a permittee:
 - ▶ (1) Is not qualified under this article;
 - ▶ (2) Has violated a provision of this article;
 - ▶ (3)Has failed to pay a required fee;
 - (4)Has failed to comply with maintenance or inspection requirements;
 - ▶ (5)Has failed to deliver trip tickets to the regulatory authority;
 - ▶ (c)The regulatory authority may revoke for a period of one (1) year or less all permits held by a liquid waste transporter if the transporter or an employee of the transporter violates any of the provisions of this article, or applicable provisions of the City Code or state law.
 - ▶ (d)A permittee whose permit is suspended or revoked shall not collect, transport, or dispose of any waste materials within the jurisdiction of the regulatory authority.

LIQUID WASTE TRANSPORTATION & DISPOSAL

Transporter Permit Required

The City's liquid waste ordinance regulates the generation, transportation, and disposal of liquid waste (grease, sand/grit, chemical toilet, and septic system wastes). The transporter must apply for a permit by submitting a liquid waste transportation permit application (PDF) with the City before hauling grease interceptor waste, grit trap waste, septic tank waste, or chemical toilet waste. Generally, liquid waste hauler permits are issued with a duration of one year (Jan. 1 through Dec. 31) and require an annual inspection. A \$200 permit fee is assessed per vehicle. Transporters who fail to obtain a permit may be subject to penalties of \$2,000 per violation per day. Liquid waste haulers must also register with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) before permitting with the City.

Maintenance Frequency

GREASE INTERCEPTORS shall be completely evacuated at a minimum of every ninety (90) days and at all other times as necessary to maintain their effectiveness.

GRIT INTERCEPTORS shall be pumped at a minimum of once per year and at all other times as necessary to maintain their effectiveness.

SEPTIC TANKS shall be pumped as often as necessary to maintain their effectiveness.

CHEMICAL TOILETS shall be pumped as often as necessary to maintain their effectiveness.

City Ordinance

- Chapter 18. Article VIII.- I Liquid Waste; Generation, Transportation, and Disposal
- Sec. 18-338. Responsibilities of liquid waste generator
 - ▶ (a) A generator of liquid waste shall have all liquid waste material picked up from the generator's premises by a liquid waste transporter who holds a valid permit from the city and the liquid waste shall be transported to an approved site for disposal.

Maintenance Frequency

Grease interceptors shall be completely evacuated at a minimum of every ninety (90) days and at all other times necessary to maintain their effectiveness.

Grit interceptors shall be pumped at a minimum of **once per year** and at all other times as necessary to maintain their effectiveness.

Septic tanks shall be pumped out as often as necessary to maintain their effectiveness.

Chemical toilets shall be pumped out as often as necessary to maintain their effectiveness.

Permitted Liquid Waste Transporter

All evacuations of grease interceptors, grit interceptors, septic tanks, and chemical toilets shall be serviced by a **permitted liquid waste transporter**.

The list of permitted liquid waste transporters can be found at **cedarhilltx.com/LWH**. Permitted transporters have a permit sticker on their trucks with the current permit year. The permit sticker color changes annually. Submit trip tickets to **LWH@cedarhilltx.com**.


