- 2. Discussion on the 2018 International Fire Code and the 2018 Regional Amendments.** The Board will review the International Fire Code Regional Amendments and other items related to the code review as deemed necessary.

Bob Morgan, Chair of the Fire Advisory Board, began the meeting by stating that all of the 2018 proposed amendments had been sent out prior to the meeting. It was asked if anyone present had any opposition to the proposed amendments, there were no oppositions voiced at the meeting. The board discussed the 2018 International Existing Building Code and the 2018 International Residential Code. There were very few changes made to these codes from the 2015 version to the 2018 version. The majority of the changes between the 2015 and the 2018 code amendments were changing the section numbers of the codes to reflect the numbering in the 2018 code documents.

The board then discussed the 2018 International Wildland Urban Interface Code (IWUIC). It was determined that the board would write a statement regarding the 2018 IWUIC code.

- 3. Action on the Proposed International Fire Code Amendments.** The Board will take a vote on the 2018 International Fire Code Amendments to recommend them forward to the Regional Codes Coordinating Committee.

The Fire Advisory Board did not have a quorum needed to vote. It was decided the board would take an electronic vote on the proposed amendments.
