1. **Welcome and Introductions.**

2. **Greater Trinity River Bacteria TMDL I-Plan Stormwater Technical Subcommittee Meeting Summary.** The December 18, 2017, meeting summary will be presented for approval. The meeting summary is available online for review.

The subcommittee approved the December 18, 2017, meeting summary.

DISCUSSION

3. **Subcommittee Project Discussion.** Staff will discuss activities pertaining to feral hog and avian management.

NCTCOG gathered information pertaining to feral hog and avian management, as requested by the subcommittee during the previous meeting. The NCTCOG presented ordinance and management case studies from cities in the DFW area, and scientific literature outlining the effects of wildlife on bacterial loadings and water quality. This information will aid environmental managers to help steer environmental policies within their respective municipalities. The subcommittee had also requested that the NCTCOG conduct research on existing feral hog sighting databases, a potential method of increasing communication on feral hog management on a regional level. NCTCOG determined that existing databases had been discontinued, and suggested creating a new database. The subcommittee agreed to create a new regional database, and gave feedback on the content. NCTCOG communicated with Texas A&M AgriLife, who attended the meeting electronically, to begin the creation of a new database.

The subcommittee was also asked to re-assess the priority of implementation strategies 2.0, 2.1, and 2.2. Strategies 2.0 and 2.2 remained the same, while strategy 2.1 was changed from low to medium.

4. **TMLD I-Plan Status Report.** Review the content and recurrence of the I-Plan Status Report.

NCTCOG staff discussed changing the frequency of the I-Plan Status Report from yearly to once every five years. The first Status Report was created in 2017 and covered the years 2013 through 2016. The 2018 Status Report covered FY 2017 work, during which minimal changes were observed. The NCTCOG staff requested the subcommittee's feedback on this suggestion. The subcommittee agreed that drafting the report on a five-year basis is sufficient and that a short summary of program achievements is adequate on a yearly basis. The NCTCOG will request the approval from the Coordination Committee to change the I-Plan Status report to a five-year report.
