Ben Pylant (Halff) provided the following task updates:

- 1) Task Order 2 project update and deliverables: The Proprietary Devices draft was sent out and is open for comments; Halff has started with the technical assistance meetings and included the task of finishing them with Task Order #3; the Maintenance and Inspections memo is open for comments.
- 2) Discuss the workplan for Task Order 3: This item was discussed and approved with the removal of line 6a.
- 3) Temporary sediment basin drawdown time discussion. *This item was not discussed and will be placed on the next available agenda.*
- 4) Stormwater standard details review: Has been reviewed by the Standard Drawings subcommittee and is open for comments.
