In 2008, FHWA began promoting certain infrastructure-oriented safety treatments and strategies, chosen based on proven effectiveness and benefits, to encourage widespread implementation by State and local transportation agencies to reduce serious injuries and fatalities on American roadways. The list of Proven Safety Countermeasures was updated in 2012 and again in 2017 and has now reached a total of 20 treatments and strategies.
