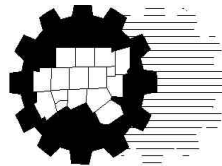

Basics

Partnership program established by the Regional Transportation Council (RTC) in February 2001.

Federal funds available through the RTC for transportation elements of sustainable development land use projects.

\$24 million available in the Dallas TxDOT District.

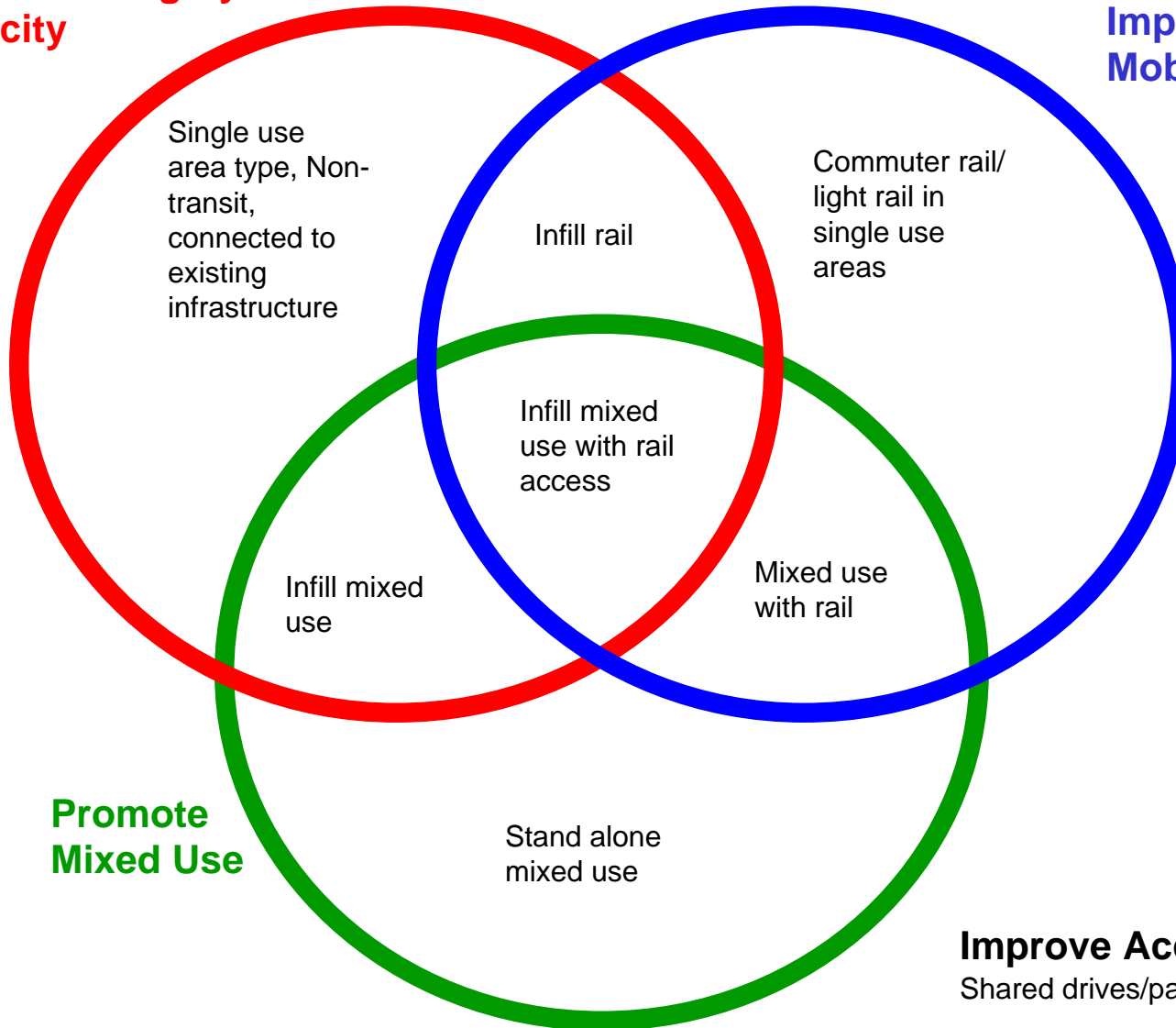
\$6 million available in the Fort Worth TxDOT District.

Land Use/Transportation Joint Venture Projects

Joint Venture Partnership

Private sector - Mixed/integrated land use or infill development or transit/pedestrian oriented buildings with reduced regional travel impact.

Local Sponsor - Appropriate land use zoning/development codes.

RTC/TxDOT- Varied transportation options eligible for federal funds.
